# MAKE YOUR OWN Leopard Mask

## SUPPLIES

- newspaper
- stiff cardstock
- pencil
- scissors
- orange and brown paint and paintbrush
- brown and black construction paper
- glue
- hole punch
- string



**1** Place a piece of newspaper on your work surface. Draw the outline of your leopard mask on the cardstock. Cut out the mask and eyeholes.

**2** Paint the front of the mask with the orange paint. After the orange coat has dried, add the leopard's spots with brown paint. Outline the eyeholes with brown paint.

**3** Cut out thin strips of black construction paper for whiskers. Using the brown construction paper, cut out an oval-shaped nose and two half-circle shapes to fit inside the ears.

**4** Once the paint on your mask has dried, glue the ears and nose onto your leopard. Glue the whiskers on the sides of the nose.

**5** Using the hole punch, make two holes on either side of the mask. Tie a piece of string to each hole. Then tie the two ends of the string behind your head to secure the mask on your face. It's time to roar!



**Variation:** You can substitute orange construction paper for the main mask and use markers to color the leopard's spots.
