GREEK GODS MEMORY GAME

Greek gods and goddesses were linked to symbols or objects that reflected their interests and personality. Many had more than one symbol. In this game, you will design one playing card for each god and goddess and one for their corresponding symbols. You can use images of the gods and their symbols within this book for reference or ask an adult to help you find images online.

SUPPLIES

- * white poster board
- * pencil
- * ruler
- * crayons
- * colored pens
- * scissors

1 Using the ruler and pencil, create a grid of 24 squares on the poster board. A common size for playing cards is 2½ by 3½ inches, but you can adjust the size.

2 Draw one god on each card. Draw the god's symbols on another card.

3 Cut out each card. Now you are ready to play the game! Ask a friend to play this game with you or play alone.

4 Place the cards in rows, face down. Turn over a card and then select another. If the cards are a match, you can go again. If not, it is the other player's turn. Keep playing until all the cards are matched.
