HONEY BEE JOURNAL

Keep track of all you do and learn in a special **Honey Bee Journal**. As you add more pages, your journal will start to look like a flower!

1 Use the ruler and pencil to mark a 1-inch margin (2½ centimeters) on two edges of each piece of paper. These two edges need to be next to each other, so choose either the top and a side or the bottom and a side.

2 Color the margins with the highlighter. Highlighters have special ink that can be seen by honey bees.

3 Punch a hole in the corner opposite the colored corner on each page. Push the brass paper fastener through the holes to hold the papers together. To make it look like a flower, fan the papers out in a circle.

4 On the top page, draw a picture of a honey bee. See the activity in Chapter 1 for step-by-step instructions.

5 For each activity or experiment you do, write your observations and results on one page in your journal. Label each page in the highlighted area.
